

SUMMARY OF SECRETARY'S REPORT TO THE DSMA COMMITTEE COVERING ACTIVITIES DURING THE PERIOD

26 OCT 25 – 17 APR 26

During the last 6-month period, the DSMA secretariat received 52 requests for DSMA Notice advice, a slight decrease over the previous period (59). The Secretariat did not issue any supplementary DSMA notices although one was drafted and remains extant. Nineteen requests were initiated by members of the UK media, 17 by Government officials and 16 by members of the public.
